## ORDINANCE # 113

## AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NUMBER 42

THE VILLAGE OF OTISVILLE ORDAINS:

Section 1.

Ordinance Number 42. Section 3 shall be amended to read as follows.

The President of the Village is hereby authorized to appoint a Chief of Police with the consent of the council.

The President of the Village is hereby authorized to appoint, upon the recommendation of the chief, Regular Police, Part-time Police and Reserve Police officers with the consent of the council.

The Regular Police officers must be a Michigan Certified Police officer or equivalent and is employed by the Village of Otisville as a full time employee.

Part-time officers are to be a Michigan Certified officer or equivalent and employed by the Village of Otisville at an hourly rate.

A Reserve\_Police officer may be either a certified or non-certified Police officer, however a reserve officer is only to work under the immediate supervision of the Chief, a Regular officer or a Part-time officer. The Reserve officer is non-paid position.

No person may be appointed a member of the Police Department unless the age of eighteen (18) years shall have been attained, be a citizen of the United States, and be mentally competent.

## Section 2.

DATE OF EFFECT. This ordinance shall take effect ten (10) days after publication as set forth below in Section 3.

## Section 3.

APPROVAL AND PUBLICATION. This ordinance was approved by a vote of the Council, a quorum being present on December 16, 1985, and ordered published in three public places in the Village of Otisville.
