#### ORDINANCE #118

# AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE #107 RELATING TO DISORDERLY PERSONS

The Village of Otisville Ordains:

Section 1.

Section 2 of Ordinance # 107 shall be amended to read as follows:

- 3. Discharge any firearm, air rifle, air pistol or bow and arrow in the village, except when lawfully acting in the defense of persons or property or the enforcement of law, or at the duly established range, the operation of which has been approved by the Chief of Police, or when by resolution of the Village Council a special game season has been declared.
  - A. Should the Village Council declare a special game season within the Village of Otisville, that season may only coincide with a special or regular season as declared by the Michigan Department of Natural Resources. A special permit to hunt within the Village of Otisville may be issued to an applicant by the Chief of Police. The individual must present, to the Chief of Police, evidence that all requirements for hunting of that specific game within the State of Michigan have been met.
  - B. All hunting laws and limitations of the Michigan Department of Natural Resources shall apply during a special hunting season within the Village of Otisville.

#### SECTION 2 - Penalties

Any individual violating the provisions of Section 1 above shall, upon conviction thereof before a court of competent jurisdiction, greater than Five Hundred (\$500.00) dollars or imprisonment in the County Jail of Genesee County, for a period not to exceed ninety (90) days, or both such fine and imprisonment in the discretion of the court who shall try such offender.

### SECTION 3 - Severability

This ordinance is deemed severable and if any part shall be declared invalid by any court, such judgment or decree shall affect only that part directly involved in the controversy.

#### SECTION 4. Date of Effect.

This Ordinance shall take effect ten (10) days after publication as set forth below.

## SECTION 5. Approval and Publication

This Ordinance was approved by a vote of the Village Council, a quorum being present on Alaten day of September 1987, and ordered published in three public places in the Village of Otisville.
