

ORDINANCE NO. 120

An Ordinance to regulate parking of motor vehicles on the streets and public thoroughfares of the Village of Otisville in order to facilitate the cleaning of said streets and thoroughfares and the removal of snow therefrom.

THE VILLAGE OF OTISVILLE ORDAINS:

SECTION ONE:

It shall be unlawful, where parking is not otherwise prohibited, for any person to stop, stand, park or leave unattended a motor vehicle on any street or public thoroughfare located within the confines of the Village of Otisville between the hours of 3:00 a.m. and 7:00 a.m.

SECTION TWO:

The provisions of this Ordinance shall be enforced only when Notice of said Ordinance is properly given by appropriate signs erected pursuant to the instructions of the Village Chief of Police or any other duly authorized officer who shall have the authority to direct that such signs be erected, said action to be in compliance with Section 606 of the Michigan Motor Vehicle Code (Section 257.606 -- MSA 9.2306), which Section provides among other things that Notice of such traffic regulations shall be posted upon or at the entrances to those areas or street to be affected in order that said Notice might be appropriate in form as to sufficiently acquaint the ordinarily observant person with the traffic regulation set forth by this Ordinance.

SECTION THREE:

Any motor vehicle parked in violation of this Ordinance shall be removed by the Chief of Police for the Village of Otisville or his duly authorized and appointed delegate at the expense of the owner of such motor vehicle. In the event that it does become necessary to remove any unlawfully parked motor vehicle in order to carry out the terms of this Ordinance, then said motor vehicle shall be impounded by Order of the Village of Otisville Chief of Police, and the owner shall be required to pay the impounding costs and the towing costs prior to the return of said vehicle, over and above any fine and costs which might be assessed by virtue of a Court hearing pursuant to the penalty clause herein-after set forth.
