ORDINANCE NO. 167

"OUTDOOR STORAGE OF DISMANTLED, PARTIALLY DISMANTLED OR INOPERABLE MOTOR VEHICLES."

The Village of Otisville Ordains:

Section 1 - Short Title

This ordinance shall be known and cited as the "Outdoor Storage of Dismantled, Partially Dismantled or Inoperable Motor Vehicles or Parts Thereof".

Section 2 - Purpose.

The purpose of this ordinance is to regulate the outdoor storage of dismantled, partially dismantled or inoperable motor vehicles in certain areas in the Village of Otisville; to provide for the issuance of permits, and to provide penalties for the violation thereof.

<u>Section 3 - Outdoor Storage of Dismantled, Partially Dismantled or Inoperable Motor Vehicles or Parts Thereof</u>

It is hereby declared to be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to store on, place on or permit to be stored or placed on or allowed to remain on any platted or unplatted parcel of land a dismantled, partially dismantled or inoperable motor vehicle or any parts of a motor vehicle, which platted or unplatted parcel of land is located in any Residential Zone, under the terms and provisions of the Zoning Ordinance of the Village, as is now or hereafter amended, or upon which parcel of land there is a structure used in whole or in part as a dwelling, unless said partially dismantled motor vehicle or parts of a motor vehicle shall be kept in a wholly enclosed garage or other wholly enclosed structure: Provided, however, that any bona fide owner, CO-owner, tenant or CO-tenant may store, permit to be stored or allow to remain on the premises of which he is the owner, CO-owner tenant or CO-tenant, any one such dismantled, partially dismantled or inoperable motor vehicle, for a period of not to exceed forty-eight (48) hours if such motor vehicle is registered in his, her or its name and provided further that any such owner, CO-owner, tenant or CO-tenant may, in the event of hardship, upon payment of the fee hereinafter provided, secure a permit from the Clerk of the Village of Otisville to extend such period of forty-eight (48) hours for an additional period of not to exceed one (1) week for any one such dismantled, partially dismantled or inoperable motor vehicle if such motor vehicle is registered in-his, her or its name; Provided further, this Ordinance shall not be construed to permit parking or placing of dismantled or partially dismantled vehicles on any street area in the Village or in any front yard, as now or hereafter defined by said Zoning Ordinance.

Section 4 - Permits

Upon application duly made by the registered owner of a motor vehicle and upon showing of hardship, the Clerk of the Village of Otisville is hereby authorized to issue the permits provided for in Section 3 hereof, a fee of One Dollar (\$1.00) for each such permit issued shall be collected and shall be paid into the general fund.

(d) The penalty provided in this section shall relate to amendments and additions to this ordinance, whether reenacted in the amendatory ordinance or not, unless such penalty is specifically repealed or amended therein.

Section 9 - Separability of Provisions

It is the intention of the Village Council that each separate provision of this ordinance shall be deemed independent of all other provisions herein, and it is further the intention of the Village Council that if any provisions of this Ordinance be declared in valid, all other provisions thereof shall remain valid and enforceable.

Section 10. Repeal of Previous Ordinances

This Ordinance shall replace Ordinance No. 70.

Section 11 - Effective Date.

This ordinance shall take effect 17th day of May, 2001.

Section 12 - Approval and Publication

This Ordinance was approved by a vote of the Village Council, a quorum being present on the 7th day of May, 2001, and ordered published in three (3) public places within the Village of Otisville.
