

Ordinance No. 185

CIVIL FINES AND MISDEMEANORS; PENALTIES:

THE VILLAGE OF OTISVILLE ORDAINS:

Section 1.

- (a) Civil Infractions. The sanction for a violation which is a municipal civil infraction shall be a civil fine in the amount as provided by applicable ordinances, plus any costs, damages, expenses, injunctive relief, and other sanctions, as authorized under Chapter 87 of Public Act 236 of 1961 (Michigan Compiled Laws 600.8701 et seq.) and other applicable laws. Costs shall include all expenses, direct and indirect, to which the Village has been put in connection with the municipal civil infraction, including the cost of prosecution.
- (b) Misdemeanors. The penalty for a misdemeanor violation shall be a fine not exceeding \$100.00, plus costs of prosecution, or imprisonment not exceeding 90 days, or both. Costs shall include all expenses, direct and indirect, to which the Village has been put in connection with the misdemeanor violation, including the cost of prosecution.

Section 2. Repealer

Any and all other ordinances or resolutions and portions thereof which are in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 3. Severability


This Ordinance is deemed severable and if any part shall be declared invalid by any court, such judgment or decree shall affect only that part directly involved in the controversy.

Section 4. Date of Effect

This Ordinance shall take effect ten (10) days after publication as set forth below.
