Amendment to Ordinance No. 74

AN ORDINANCE TO REGULATE THE USE OF SNOWMOBILES AND ALL-TERRAIN-VEHICLES

THE VILLAGE OF OTISVILLE ORDAINS:

Section 18. The Otisville Police Department, the Cenesee County Sheriff's Department, and the Michigan State Police are hereby authorized to impound any unregistered snowmobile which is parked on or being operated on lands not owned or possessed by the owner or operator of said snowmobile. The said police departments are hereby authorized to hold said snowmobiles until such time as proof of registration has been furnished. A storage fee shall be charged for such impounded snowmobiles at the rate of \$1.00 per day and, in addition, a charge shall be levied for any costs incurred by the said police departments in transporting the said snowmobiles to their place of storage.

This Amendment to Ordinance No. 74 was approved by unanimous vote of the Village Council, a quorum being present on February 4, 1974, and ordered published in three public places in the Village of Otisville within ten (10) days after its adoption.
