

THE VILLAGE OF OTISVILLE ORDAINS:

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCES RELATIVE TO HAWKERS, PEDDLERS, ITINERANT MERCHANTS AND TRANSIENT VENDORS.

SECTION 1. That no person shall follow the business of a hawker or peddler or itinerant merchant or transient vendor within the limits of the Village of Otisville, without first obtaining a license therefor as hereinafter provided; provided, however, that no such license shall be required if the said business is conducted exclusively upon private property with written permission of the owner, lessee or occupant of such property.

SECTION 2. That the Village Clerk is hereby authorized to issue a license in the name of the Common Council, to any person to follow the business or occupation of a hawker or peddler or itinerant merchant or transient vendor within the limits of said Village, upon his paying to the Village Treasurer the sum prescribed in the next section.

SECTION 3. That any person receiving such license shall pay therefor as follows: the sum of Twenty-five (\$25.00) Dollars per day, or part thereof.

SECTION 4. That such license may be denied or revoked by a majority vote of the Village Council at a general or special meeting for good cause shown.

SECTION 5. That any violation of or failure to comply with any provision of this Ordinance shall be punished by a fine of One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars and costs of prosecution, or by imprisonment in the County Jail for ten (10) days, or both such fine and imprisonment, in the discretion of the Court.

SECTION 6. DATE OF EFFECT. This Ordinance shall take effect twenty (20) days after the date hereof, to-wit: the 26th day of June, 1977.

SECTION 7. APPROVAL AND PUBLICATION. This Ordinance was approved by unanimous vote of the Village Council, a quorum being present on June 6, 1977, and ordered published in three public places in the Village of Otisville within ten (10) days after the date of its adoption.

SECTION 8. This Ordinance hereby repeals Ordinance No. 11, Ordinance No. 19, and Ordinance No. 40 of the Village of Otisville in their entireties.
