

THE VILLAGE OF OTISVILLE ORDAINS:

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 79, TO PROVIDE FOR THE REPEAL OF SECTION 9.3 OF THE UNIFORM TRAFFIC CODE ADOPTED BY ORDINANCE NO. 79 AND TO PROVIDE A NEW PENALTY PROVISION TO COMPLY WITH PUBLIC ACT 300 OF THE PUBLIC ACTS OF 1949, AS AMENDED, AND SPECIFICALLY SECTION 907 THEREOF.

SECTION 9.3. PENALTY

SECTION 1.

Any provision of this Ordinance which describes an act or omission which constitutes a civil infraction under the terms of the Michigan Vehicle Code, being Public Act 300, of 1949, as amended, shall be processed as a civil infraction and any person found to have committed a civil infraction may be ordered to pay a civil fine of no more than \$100.00 and costs in accordance with Section 907 of the Michigan Vehicle Code.

Violation of any other provisions of this Ordinance not constituting a civil infraction, as herein provided, shall be punishable by a fine of not more than \$100.00 or imprisonment for not more than 90 days, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

SECTION 2. DATE OF EFFECT.

This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect twenty (20) days after its passage by the Village Council, said effective date being August 26, 1979.

SECTION 3. APPROVAL AND PUBLICATION.

This Ordinance was approved by unanimous vote of the Village Council, a quorum being present on August 6, 1979, and ordered published in three public places in the Village of Otisville within ten (10) days after its adoption.
