

AN ORDINANCE TO CONTROL THE PURCHASE, POSSESSION AND TRANSPORTATION OF ALCOHOLIC LIQUOR BY MINORS.

THE VILLAGE OF OTISVILLE ORDAINS:

SECTION 1. DEFINITION

"Alcoholic liquor" shall include any spirituous, vinous, malt or fermented liquor, liquids and compounds, whether or not medicated, proprietary, patented, and by whatever name called, containing 1/2 of 1 per cent or more of alcohol by volume which are fit for use for beverage purposes.

SECTION 2.

No person under the age of twenty-one (21) shall purchase or knowingly possess or transport any alcoholic liquor within the Village of Otisville, or knowingly possess, transport or have under his control in any motor vehicle any alcoholic liquor within the said Village unless said person is employed by a licensee, licensed pursuant to Michigan statute, and is possessing, transporting or having such alcoholic liquor in a motor vehicle under his control during working hours and in the course of his employment.

SECTION 3. VIOLATION.

Violation of the terms of this Ordinance by any person shall be punishable by a fine of \$100.00, or ninety (90) days imprisonment in the County Jail, or both.

SECTION 4. DATE OF EFFECT.

This Ordinance shall take effect on January 17, 1980.

SECTION 5. APPROVAL AND PUBLICATION.

This Ordinance was approved by unanimous vote of the Village Council, a quorum being present on January 7, 1980, and ordered published in three public places in the Village of Otisville within ten (10) days after the date of its adoption.

SECTION 6.

This Ordinance hereby repeals Ordinance No. 85 of the Village of Otisville, said Ordinance having been adopted on February 3, 1975 and having taken effect on February 13, 1975.
