

AN ORDINANCE TO PROHIBIT THE MALICIOUS DESTRUCTION OF PROPERTY

THE VILLAGE OF OTISVILLE ORDAINS:

SECTION 1.

Any person who shall willfully and maliciously destroy, injure, remove, break, deface and/or mutilate any real or personal property of another shall be guilty of a misdemeanor.

SECTION 2. VIOLATION.

Violation of the terms of this Ordinance by any person shall be punishable by a fine of \$100.00, or ninety (90) days imprisonment in the County Jail, or both.

SECTION 3. DATE OF EFFECT.

This Ordinance shall take effect on July 17, 1980.

SECTION 4. APPROVAL AND PUBLICATION.

This Ordinance was approved by unanimous vote of the Village Council, a quorum being present on July 7, 1980, and ordered published in three public places in the Village of Otisville within ten (10) days after the date of its adoption.
