VILLAGE OF OTISVILLE DRIVING FAST HORSES Ordinance No. 12

An Ordinance prohibiting fast driving and horse racing in the streets of the Village of Otisville.

SECTION 1:

That no person shall immoderately drive or ride any horse, horses or other animals in any of the streets of said Village.

SECTION 2:

No person or persons shall do any speeding or racing in any of the public streets in said Village.

SECTION 3:

Any person or persons who shall drive or ride in any of the streets of said Village at a greater rate of speed than seven miles an hour, shall be deemed guilty of immoderately riding or driving, as the case may be.

SECTION 4:

It shall be the duty of the Marshal to immediately stop any person offending against the provisions of this Ordinance, placing him under arrest and make complaint again such offending person or persons.

SECTION 5:

Any person convicted of violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance, shall, upon conviction, be punished by a fine not to exceed fifty dollars and costs of prosecution, and in default of payment of such fine and costs shall be imprisoned in the County jail or Village Lock-up not exceeding sixty days, unless such fine and costs are sooner paid.
