

VILLAGE OF OTISVILLE
AMEND ORDINANCE #10 (EXHIBITS & SHOWS)
Ordinance No. 20

An Ordinance relative to exhibitions and shows.

The Village of Otisville ordains:

SECTION 1:

That Section 3 of an Ordinance relative to exhibitions and shows, approved October 14, 1907 be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION 3:

Any person, persons or company soliciting such license shall pay therefore as follows: For anyone of the public exhibitions above described, when given in a tent, pavilion or amphitheater, at which an admission fee of more than twenty-five cents is charged, the sum of five dollars for any one of the public exhibitions above describe at which an admission fee of twenty-five cents or less is charged, three dollars.

SECTION 2:

This amendment to said ordinance shall take effect twenty days after its passage.
